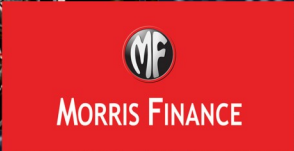

## PRESIDENT'S (CHAIRMAN) REPORT

In late 2020 we welcomed back Marty Mattner as Senior Men's Coach in the next chapter of our football Club. His impact was significant which was demonstrated in the second half of the season with a win ratio of 7:2.



Fast forward 12 months, and despite having to navigate the challenges the Covid-19 pandemic continues to create it is timely to reflect and acknowledge our achievements:

- We have finished the year in a strong financial position, posting a profit from operations of \$852,447
- We have paid off our bank debt which is an incredible turnaround from just a few years ago
- *Building the Blues* - The construction of Stage II of the Unley Oval Redevelopment Upgrade project commences in early 2022. With an expected end-of-year completion date, the precinct vision created back in 1976 will finally become a reality, creating a state-of-the-art facility equipped to complement the future needs of our growing Club, both on and off-field
- We experienced a growth in membership reaching 3,949 members and had an elevated level of engagement with members throughout the year
- We welcomed and extended long-standing partnerships affirming our position as a valuable commercial brand
- We made considerable progress on our strategic agenda, including discussions with Urrbrae High School, The Education Department, and SANFL regarding the masterplan and redevelopment of our second oval, necessary to accommodate our growing football programs
- We continue negotiations and planning for the relocation of our hospitality venue while navigating complex legislation
- Led by Senior Coach Marty Mattner, we continued to develop a club-wide football program that would build talent for the future, deliver a clearly identifiable game style, and display consistent effort throughout the seasons
- Eight players made their league debut for the senior men and nine for the senior women
- We won the inaugural Novita SANFL Wheelchair Premiership against archrivals Norwood

Despite the frustrations created by Covid-19, members continued to support us with the passion we have come to expect. I take this opportunity to thank you all for your unyielding loyalty to the Club.

I also thank our many and varied commercial partners including Morris Finance, Thomas Farms, Australian Gas Networks, and Santos as well as our corporate and coterie groups for their continued support and care for our Club.

In closing, thank you once again for your unwavering support.

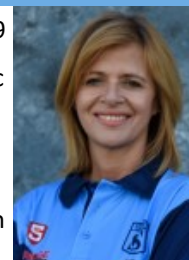

## CEO'S REPORT

To state the obvious, both the 2020 and 2021 years have been like no other. COVID-19 affected us all, and the recovery process lingers on. Despite the challenges, I am optimistic about the future and confident that the Club will emerge strongly.



Sturt has experienced turbulent times in its 120-year history. We have come through hardships such as two world wars, the Spanish Flu pandemic, the Great Depression, the Global Financial Crisis, and too many, documented occasions, where financial mismanagement has nearly cost us the Club.

The strength of the Club's Board and sound operating model helped us withstand the negative effects of COVID. Our prudent fiscal management held us in good stead, further demonstrating the non-negotiable fundamentals underlying the business of the Club.

There is much to celebrate including:

- We are debt-free
- We are contributing \$1,000,000 to Stage II of the Unley Oval redevelopment project, in addition to the \$750,000 made to Stage I
- Stage II of the Unley Oval redevelopment project will be completed in the next year
- We have significant cash at the bank
- We are working through government legislation to relocate our hospitality venue
- We have purchased three new vehicles for our football programs
- We have added a new women's reserve team
- We have increased our male Under 16 program
- We have added a wheelchair team
- We are progressing our second oval master plan to accommodate our growing programs at Urrbrae High School
- Our creditors remain current
- This is our eighth consecutive operating surplus
- Sponsorship is the highest it has ever been with many multi-year agreements

I am confident we will deliver another good financial result for the year ahead. That is not to say things are back to normal. We remain cautious and will watch our expenses carefully as we navigate through the COVID recovery.

Your Club is known for its commitment to the community. That has never been more evident than during COVID, and bushfire crisis. We responded with relief for people impacted by both events. That community-centred approach forms part of our DNA.

Our commitment to better social outcomes has also been the driver for the implementation of environmental initiatives, *Double Blues Go Green* and the *Double Blue Laundry* project assisting homeless people.

In partnership with Green Industries S.A., we diverted a staggering 96% of matchday waste from landfills during the 2021 season. Members and supporters would have likely interacted with our matchday waste warriors who have put the Club at the forefront of event waste management.

We have witnessed an increase in homelessness in and around the Unley area. In conjunction with the Salvation Army, we offer up our change rooms one morning per week to the homeless to shower and use the laundry facilities.

We continue to experience the acceleration in the shift to digital technology. Over this past year, we have undergone a process to transform our operations to better meet the changing needs of the football landscape.

Despite not playing senior men or women's finals in 2021 I am excited for what these young teams will produce in 2022 and beyond with the expectation that is building. We are aptly positioned for success that is underpinned by our renowned Club culture, the best in the league.

Season 2021 was not completely absent of silverware. The inaugural wheelchair team was undefeated and won the premiership beating arch-rivals Norwood by 42 points at the Lights Community Centre. This competition offers another dimension to the Club exposing our brand to different markets.

The team captained by Steve "Budgie" Avery has wholeheartedly bought into the Club culture and our existing teams have welcomed them all. It is refreshing to see the camaraderie that is evolving between all our football programs.

I am full of admiration for the team of individuals that I feel honoured to work with each day and who are all committed to the Club's mission of continuous improvement.

In closing, I would also like to thank President Jason Kilic for his leadership and counsel, and the members of the Board for their stewardship of your Club.

This is now a strong and resilient Club. We are well-positioned for strong performances both on and off-field in the coming years. I am excited about what the future holds.

## FOOTBALL MANAGER'S REPORT

Season 2021 was a year of regeneration and a changing of the guard for the Sturt Football Club. We welcomed back Senior Coach Martin Mattner after a stint as an assistant at the Adelaide Crows and were able to clearly see strong development within a young playing group. The League side finished 6th at the conclusion of the season just a game out of the finals after a slow start adapting to a modified game plan.



As the season progressed the players fortified and finished the year strongly winning 7 of the last 9 matches. 34 players represented Sturt at League level this season with 8 of those players making their League debut for the Club. As it stands the playing list is very strong and with continued growth will return hungry for success in season 2022.

Credit for the continued success of the Senior and Junior programs must be shared by many hard-working Sturt people however this couldn't be possible without the direction and support of the Board, in particular Jason Kilic as President and Chris Thredgold as Football Director. Jason and Chris' leadership drives the football department in a positive direction as we strive for continuous improvement.

The Senior coaching group led by Martin Mattner worked tirelessly to provide a quality learning and playing environment. The team has established a strong culture and we look forward to seeing them continue to develop and push for a finals spot in 2022. The program was well organised by Michael Higgs (Women's Football Manager) and Jackson Lane (Women's Football Coordinator).

David Oatey (U18s) and Michael Higgs (U16s) once again coached the Sturt youth teams and they along with a dedicated team of assistant coaches continue to do an excellent job of developing the young talent in our promotional zone.

Results were hard to come by for the U18s due in part to the college/non-college make-up of the squad as well as the selection of many U18 players in the Reserves team. We look forward to seeing many of these young players progress through the ranks in future years.

2022 brings with it a new season and great expectations from a young and talented Senior playing group. The Club will retain a majority of the playing list as well as recruit a select number of quality players. The Club's philosophy will continue to focus on development and providing an opportunity to our own local players.

We had some key retirements in 2021 including past Premiership players Zane Kirkwood, Matthew Crocker, Mark Evans and Jake Sutcliffe. We thank them for their great contribution to the Club and wish them all the best in retirement.

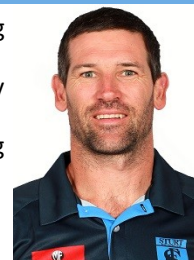
Pre-season will be upon us soon where our focus will be on the progression of our next crop of Premiership players who will wear the Double Blue guernsey with pride.

## CLUB COACH REPORT

Season 2021 saw the playing group take positive steps in setting the foundation for long term success. Despite not making finals (which was disappointing), we achieved some key goals set at the start of the year. Two of those key goals was the development and providing the opportunity to play League football for the Club's younger players.



Our performances in the second half of the season showed that the brand of football we want to play will put us in a great position for 2022. Missing the finals in 2021 will only drive the group to continue to improve and achieve their goals in 2022.

The season was a tale of two halves.

The first half saw inconsistent performances and results showed two wins seven losses and games where we played well for two or three quarters.

Two players were drafted into the AFL System via the mid-season draft. Ash Johnson was drafted with pick 3 to Collingwood Football Club and Jed McEntee was drafted with pick 13 by Port Adelaide Football Club. While Charlie Parker was selected by the Western Bulldogs with pick 17 at the AFL rookie draft. We wish these players the best with their AFL careers.

Congratulations to half back Casey Voss, midfielders Tom Lewis and James Battersby on selection into the 2021 SANFL Team of the Year.

## HIGH PERFORMANCE MANAGER'S REPORT

Season 2021 did not pan out the way we thought it might back in November 2020. We all felt we had a very good list, and we were excited to see what the season held. By R18 in August 2021 we had completed 220 hours of training and played 4 trials and 18 minor round matches and we finished bottom and had some huge losses.



We started with a list of 51 players, 22 were college. We started with 3 U19s and by round 3, 2 had retired back to amateur footy and only one remained. We ended up playing 60 players in the 18 games, 2 U19s, 26 U18s, 19 U17s and 13 U16s. We had 10 players play Reserves this year.

We had no player play all U18 games, Jake Aish and Jamie Taylor were our most capped with 16 games.

We won 3 games and lost 15, we were the lowest scoring team with 984 points for the year, which means we averaged 9 goals per game, our aim for each match is 16 goals and we only managed this 3 times for the year, twice against Centrals (who finished 7th) and once in R1 against the Eagles (they were the eventual Premier and we were able to defeat them when we had a full list in Round 1).

We had 4 players in the SA U19 team, Will Spain, Zac Becker, Morgan Ferres and Mani Liddy. We had 5 players in the SA U17 squad, Nick Sadler and Pat Tidemann as U17s and Luca Slade, Loch Rawlinson and Alex Holt as U16s.

They are the facts, but the story of the season was not as bleak as the Premiership table shows. Having 10 players playing regularly in the senior program is a huge benefit for them. We aim for 2 players drafted and 2 others to play League football from each age group. Having 10 in the system already should mean we achieve those goals in the next 2 years from the U18 age group.

We played 13 U16s which is great for exposing those players to the standard they need to reach in the next 2 years. It should provide that group of players a huge training advantage going into this preseason. They are now aware of the standard and will drive training to get the most from the 5-month preseason block coming up.

I really enjoyed the training effort by all the players, we ended up with a list of 72 players who have done a solid training block in 2021. The players never waned in their efforts during 3 sessions a week for 9 months and hopefully this will make them better players in 2022 and beyond. The players never blamed each other when the matchday results were not at the level we wanted, it was great to see them persist with the goal of being as good as they can be and I want to thank all the leaders, Charles Fryer (Captain),

There is more to football than winning and losing and I hope everyone involved this year enjoyed the season and will take some great memories from the time this group spent together.

The Under 16's had some good results playing in the finals in Season 2021. COVID impacted our pre-season trials resulting in a smaller than usual group.

A squad of 40 was selected from 68 players that included seven Under 15 players. The team played brilliant football throughout the season exhibiting both their talents and what they learned. They finished the season with five wins and two losses before losing the semi-final.



Border closures due to COVID affected the State programs. Despite this, Under 17 players Luca Slade, Alex Holt and Loch Rawlinson were selected to represent the State and George Pope played in the Futures Games.

I had great support from my Under 16 coaching team and would like to thank, Greg Crowden, Zane Kirkwood, Nigel Grivell, Gary Mutton, Chris Brown, Bailey Hough, Niamh Montague, and Scott Vears. I make special mention of Centre of Excellence Head Trainer, Tamara Lane who has done a wonderful job going above and beyond what is expected in that role.

The male Development Squads occurred in Term Two for the Under 13 and Under 14's and Term Three for Under 15's. The 30 player squads were made up of Country and Metro players and included 10-12 training sessions and five games. The players exhibited solid learning in their application and have a good understanding of what Sturt Football Club represents.

I thank our Development Squad coaches Greg Crowden, Scott Vears, Zac Milbank, Connor Willismore, Dylan Matteucci, Joe Hargreaves, Paul Greaves, Paul Harris, Sam Spain. Oliver Small, Mitch Noye, Cooper Skinner, Phil Johnston, Henry Bruce, Simon Muster and Matt Lynn.

Again I recognise Centre of Excellence Head Trainer, Tamara Lane and thank Sally Miell for managing the medical needs of the Development Squads and Senior Head Trainer, Nick Swinger for helping out when time permitted around his senior commitments.

The Under 14 and 16 Female Development Squads were excellently managed by Women's Coordinator, Jackson Lane. This program was the same as the Under 15 Males. They trained one week in Mount Barker and one week at Unley Oval to assist the Country players and Unley Oval's maintenance program.

The improvement in the players, in particular the older age group, was significant with both teams winning three of five games. These players will make up the majority of our newly, introduced SANFLW Development League squad in 2022.

A personal thank you to the Club for employing Jackson Lane to help me with the SANFLW program. He has shown himself to be a dedicated worker who leaves no stone unturned and has earned the respect of the playing and coaching group.

I also wish to thank Jackson's coaching team Bruce Dawes, Hannah Prenzler, Kiera Mueller, Maya Rigter, Abe Abraham, and Chris Brown. I again thank Sally Miell for her medical care and Nick Swinger and Tamara Lane for assisting when needed.

In his second year SANFLW Head Coach, Bruce Dawes was able to produce our best win loss record to date, three wins, seven losses and a draw. These results do not highlight the improvement of the squad where we lost several games by one - four points which had we have won would have seen us with five - six wins.

We had 45 players in the program with nine making their league debut. We continue to build our core through our younger players aged 16-21. Alisha Gepp being recognised as a Powerade Breakthrough Player and Alisha and Izzy Kuiper capped off wonderful seasons by making The Advertiser SANFLW Team of the Year.

We are starting to see the results of the program with junior player Zoe Prowse drafted to the Adelaide Football Club. Jess Good, who made the switch from basketball, after one season, was drafted to the Carlton Football Club. Georgia Bevan was drafted to Gold Coast Football Club at the beginning of the 2021 season but has again signed on with us for 2022.

The Best and Fairest award was won by Izzy Kuiper, Jaimee Wittervan was Runner-up and Kiera Mueller Emerging Talent. Captain, Maya Rigter won the Most Valuable Player award, as voted by her peers and was the recipient of the inaugural SA Power Networks Leadership award as the best leader in the SANFLW.

I would like to thank our SANFLW coaching and medical team, Michael O'Connor, Jackson Lane, Nikki Moore, Brooke Chaplin, Cherie Bamford, Jacquie Addison, Zahi Khouri, Abe Abraham, Liam Greenslade, Muktika Tandon and Bruce Dawes.

Thank you to Sturt Football Club for my fifth year of employment. Due to the expansion of the Women's and Junior football programs in 2022, I am looking forward to my role changing next season which will see me coaching the Under 18's. I am excited to work with Jackson Lane who will manage Women's Football. I trust that I can fast track his development just as David Oatey, Chris Trapp and Marty Mattner did mine when I began at the Club.

Furthermore, we required a facility that would allow our increasing number of supporters to feel part of the Club and to create a destination accessible to the community.

The Building the Blues project is the most significant project undertaken in the Club's history. It came about after exhaustive research, consultation and due diligence.

We are determined to place the Club at the forefront of elite, State based sporting and community facilities, and to ensure that the home of Sturt Football Club, Unley Oval is a place where all feel welcomed and engaged.

- New canteen facilities & merchandise shop
- Disabled access to Unley Oval grandstand terraces

### Stage II

- Community hub/multi purpose function room located in The Jack Oatey Grandstand
- Offices, media stand & coaches boxes in The Jack Oatey Grandstand

In conjunction with The City of Unley, State & Federal Government, AFL and our supporters, Stage I of the Building the Blues project was completed in 2018. Stage I has delivered a state-of-the-art change room facility that meets the demands of our elite pathway programs including women's and wheelchair football.

Stage II is being funded by the Club, City of Unley & Federal Government. Stage II starting in early 2022 and budgeted at \$4.5m, will deliver a community hub, multi-use, function facility atop The Jack Oatey Grandstand that will allow our increasing number of supporters to feel part of the Club and create a destination accessible to the whole community.

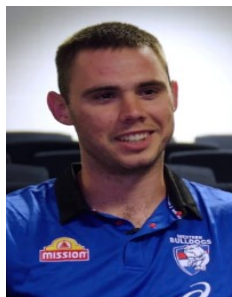
