## PRESIDENT'S (CHAIRMAN) REPORT

After more than two years of dealing with the impact of COVID-19, it was good to play a season not dominated by restrictions and health & safety protocols.

I believe that Sturt Football Club (Club) assisted many members and supporters in confronting the challenges of COVID-19 restrictions by providing moments of on-field joy and connection.



I thank those who worked hard through these difficult times, the staff, players, officials, and volunteers. Their commitment to the Club and the SANFL has been outstanding.

On field, we played finals in all grades except Under 16 boys.

Our senior women surpassed expectations making the grand final, however, fell short of a very experienced North Adelaide. Congratulations to players Kiera Mueller drafted to Adelaide and Alex Ballard drafted to Port Adelaide.

There was never any doubt that our wheelchair team would again be the premiers. We continue to be the hunted in that competition as the other teams improve.

Our reserve men had a superb season and capped it off by beating North Adelaide in a very enjoyable grand final-game. It is a testament to our depth and will be exciting for season 2023 when some of these players make their league debut.

The performance of our league men did not match our high expectations. However, we returned to playing in the finals, something we have not done since 2019. Whilst no excuse, injury to key players, in particular our midfield, did not help.

Rest assured that the football department is diligently working on the 2023 playing lists.

One of our major concerns is the way in which players are drafted into the AFL system, particularly the mid-season draft. Whilst we accept and celebrate that SANFL is the pathway to the AFL and that Sturt quite proudly produces numerous players, the balance is not right. We have found it increasingly difficult over the past few years to plan, retain and recruit players when dealing with three separate drafts, yearly concessions for the two South Australian AFL reserve teams and the constant push to raid more talent.

Whilst we continue to work collaboratively with the SANFL for the benefit of the competition, it is challenging.

So what is the long-term view for our competition? We believe it will be more of the same and not wanting to sound pessimistic it feels like “death by a thousand cuts”

On a positive note, the work done in the last ten years to fulfil the Club's fifty-year vision to build a state-of-the-art facility for future generations, has become a reality. The board and management after relentless lobbying and raising necessary funds, have been able to deliver on the project we call *Building the Blues*.

The Club's contribution to the precinct is nearing \$2M, an outstanding contribution by a State League Club to an asset it will never own and a testament to the generosity of our benefactors, sponsors, members, and supporters.

The result is beyond exceptional.

Thank you to everyone who has donated to this project including the City of Unley and the federal government.

I look forward to hosting pre-match functions overlooking Unley Oval next season. The match-day hospitality options the development creates are numerous and provide additional revenue opportunities for the Club and an unrivalled match-day experience for users.

We will lay claim to the title of destination club with this state-of-the-art facility, something all members and supporters can be proud of.

We continue to financially perform well, posting yet another operating surplus. The prudent management of the Club's finances has enabled us to contribute more than first estimated to the *Building the Blues* project and navigate the current, turbulent economic times.

Despite the unexpected yet pleasing extension to our lease of hospitality venue Jack's on Unley, we eventually will have to relocate. The decisions around relocation are of paramount importance to the future sustainability of the Club and we must get it right.

Much work is still to be done as we adapt to an ever-changing environment, however, I am confident that the diversity and richness of experience that everyone brings to this Club will ensure we succeed.

## CEO'S REPORT

It was over 10 years ago that I joined the Board. I was appointed General Manager (now CEO) in late 2013, the first female in SANFL history to be a Board Member and to lead a club.

The financial issues facing the Club at that time were common knowledge and it was not known if we would survive.



Fast forward 10 years and achievements include but are not limited to:

- We are debt free
- Creditors are current
- Have cash at the bank
- Investments in high-yield accounts
- Contributed up to \$2M in upgrading the Unley Oval precinct
- Boast state-of-the-art facilities including four change rooms, administration offices, a function room, corporate boxes, etc.
- Men's league premiers (2016 & 2017)
- Introduced Women's team in 2018 & played in Grand Final in 2022
- Introduced Wheelchair team in 2021 & two premierships (2021 & 2022)

Unlike other SANFL clubs, there was no forgiveness of debt, a white knight, or magic applied in creating the on and off-field success. It was all down to a lot of hard work and common-sense strategic decisions that were implemented by the Board and Management that finds the Club in its current position.

This year marks our ninth consecutive operating surplus and the only Club in the SANFL to boast nearly a decade of responsible financial management.

Of utmost importance are the Club's long-term sustainability and the goal that future Boards and Management do not inherit what we did over a decade ago.

The Jack's on Unley lease expires in early 2025. Relocation will not be an easy process due to government legislation regarding the movement of gaming machines. This exercise is the biggest issue currently facing the Club and must be managed appropriately.

## FOOTBALL MANAGER'S REPORT

In Senior Coach Martin Mattner's second year back in charge at the Club the plan was to build on the foundations that were laid in 2021 and push for a finals berth.



The League side had an impressive start to the year culminating in a 5-1 record however long term injuries to key midfielders Patrick Wilson and Tom Lewis hurt our momentum forcing some adjustments mid-season.

The side got back on track and finished 5th at the conclusion of the season earning a finals berth, but unfortunately our season finished in the Elimination Final against Glenelg however the young Senior group will be better for the experience.

We had 36 players represent Sturt at League level this season with 11 of those players making their League debut for the Club.

Credit for the continued success of the Senior and Junior programs must be shared by many hard-working Sturt people however this couldn't be possible without the direction and support of the Board, in particular Jason Kilic as President and Chris Thredgold as Football Director. Jason and Chris' leadership drives the football department in a positive direction as we strive for continuous improvement.

We were pleased to have an experienced and passionate Senior coaching group who worked tirelessly to provide a quality learning and playing environment. This group was led by Senior Coach Martin Mattner and well supported by League assistant coaches Russell Godson (midfield), Scott Tidemann (defence) and Gavin Hughes (forwards). The strength and conditioning program was headed up by Blake Ashby with assistance from Hayden Conlay. Jack Osborn continued his role as ruck coach and League bench coach and Jye DeZylva acted as League runner.

I again enjoyed coaching the Reserves squad in season 2022. The young group had a fantastic season culminating in a Premiership. This experience will assist to fast-track development and promises an exciting future for the Club. A big thank you must go to Scott Cramey (midfield), Shane Tongerie (forwards) and John Corbett (defence) who acted as Reserves assistant coaches and to Brett May (bench coach) and Hayden Conlay (runner) who all provided excellent support for myself and the players.

The U18s made it to the 1st Semi-Final unfortunately going down by 2 points, while the U16s had a strong season but narrowly missed out on a finals berth. We look forward to seeing these young players progress through the ranks in future years.

Sturt's Wheelchair team led by Steven Avery as Captain had another successful season in 2022 winning the Premiership again. Jackson Lane (Wheelchair Football Coordinator) once again did a great job in managing the program.

2023 brings with it a new season and great expectations from a young and talented Senior playing group. Continued internal growth among the playing group as well as a few key additions will set us up for a successful season in 2023.

The Club's philosophy will continue to focus on development and providing an opportunity to our own local players. Pre-season is currently upon us where our focus is on the progression of our next crop of Premiership players who will wear the Double Blue guernsey with pride.

## CENTRE OF EXCELLENCE MANAGER'S REPORT

Season 2022 saw some significant changes within the Centre of Excellence Program. With Stage II of the Jack Oatey Stand under construction we combined the Metropolitan and Country Under 13 and Under 14 Squads to make 2 squads of 60 instead of 4 squads of 30. The Under 16s also became a full-length season.



Due to the full length-season my role changed and I moved back into working only with the male programs. This was a positive change allowing me to focus more time on fewer roles, players and volunteers.

The Under 13 and Under 14 squads had 2 trial sessions, 10 training's and 5 games. The players trained at the Summit Sport and Recreation Park in Mount Barker due to the added traffic on Unley Oval.

They were able to show great learning and progression in skills, and game sense throughout the program as well as making the first steps in professionalism by utilising foam rollers and watching vision.

The Under 15s were split into 2 squads, 1 for Country and 1 for Metro. Their program was the same as the Under 13s and Under 14s except they only played 4 games, with 3 of these taking place in the Intra State Carnival, where both teams finished with a 1-2, win-loss record.

I moved into the Under 18 coaching role in 2022 and was able to work with an amazing group of players. We had over 85 players trial before Christmas before selecting 57 players to continue in January.

We finished the year with an 11-7 record and with the second-best attack in the competition. Unfortunately we lost the Elimination Final to eventual premiers Glenelg by 2 points. In the final we played 16 Under 17s which leaves us in a great position to attack season 2023.

Chad Reschke was the leading goal kicker in the Under 18s and finished second in the McCallum Tomkins Medal. Chad also took home the Club Best and Fairest, the Simon John Pfeiffer Medal just ahead of Thomas McCourt who was the Runner Up in the Best and Fairest (Jackson Marsh Memorial Trophy). Zac Llewellyn, Ryan Turner and Brodie Maloney won their line groups Coaches Awards and the Captain Blake Fidge won the Best Team Man Award (Frank Dodd Memorial Trophy).

I would also like to thank the Sturt Football Club for having me on board for my sixth year. I thoroughly enjoyed coaching a full-length season and combining this with my administration and work with the Development Squads.

## HIGH PERFORMANCE MANAGER'S REPORT

Under 16's preseason training commenced in November 2021 and after the Christmas break, 57 players were invited to train for matchday selection in season 2022.



Of the 57 players selected, 22 attended college, so during the school terms II and III there was a maximum of 35 players available for selection. At seasons end, all but 3 players had been selected to play a minor round game for Sturt.

At the completion of the season the team had played 3 trials and 18 minor round matches. Your team won 10 games and lost 8 (3 by less than a goal) and finished fifth. The team had a percentage of 56.60% (second highest in the competition), were the fourth highest scoring team with 1333 points and was the best defensive team, only conceding 1022 points.

The aims of the program were achieved. Having almost every player involved in a minor round game meant they got a good understanding of what is required to be a top end player and play League football for Sturt.

The best players were challenged by playing all games they were available for selection and leading the team and by being involved in the South Australian Under 16 team. Ned Atkinson was the Captain of the Sturt team, and he was a State U16 player along with Cameron Kelly, Alex Dodson, Jasper Maher and Wil Thomas.

In the State U15 team Sturt was represented by Harley Barker, Noah Roberts-Thomson, Gill Wakelin and Kalen Russell.

Kobee Dabinett was named the Most Valuable Player with Cameron Kelly coming Runner Up while also along with Noah Roberts-Thomson and Blake Langton winning the Coaches Awards.

## BUILDING THE BLUES - THE NEXT PROJECT

Since 2014 the Club has contributed close to \$2M to Unley Oval upgrades including:

- Picket fence
- New lighting & poles
- Electronic scoreboard/screen
- PA system
- Goal posts & pads
- Four Unisex change & locker rooms
- Canteen
- Retail shop
- Medical facilities
- Gymnasium & Pilates rooms
- Ice baths
- Coaches' boxes
- Media deck
- Administration offices
- Function room & other corporate facilities



No other Unley community sporting organisation has come close to contributing that amount of money towards Council assets that the Club will never own.

In addition to the Club's contribution, Board member David Reynolds has voluntarily project-managed Stage I and Stage II saving both the Club and council many thousands of dollars.

With the completion of Stage II to upgrade the Jack Oatey Grandstand facilities, we turn our focus to future projects that include the development of Urrbrae High School as our second oval; upgraded scoreboard, and perimeter fence. In addition, we must implement an asset renewal plan.

Due to the increase in football programs, we require a second home to train and play junior and women's games. We are working with Urrbrae High School, the Education Department, SANFL, and AFL to install 150 Lux lighting, install new goal posts and netting, oval surface upgrades, and eventual change rooms.

The works will start with the installation of lighting and new goal posts. This stage will cost approximately \$500,000. A grant application for a Community Recreation and Sports Facilities grant has been lodged with the Office of Recreation. The AFL has committed \$50,000 to be paid at the completion of the project.

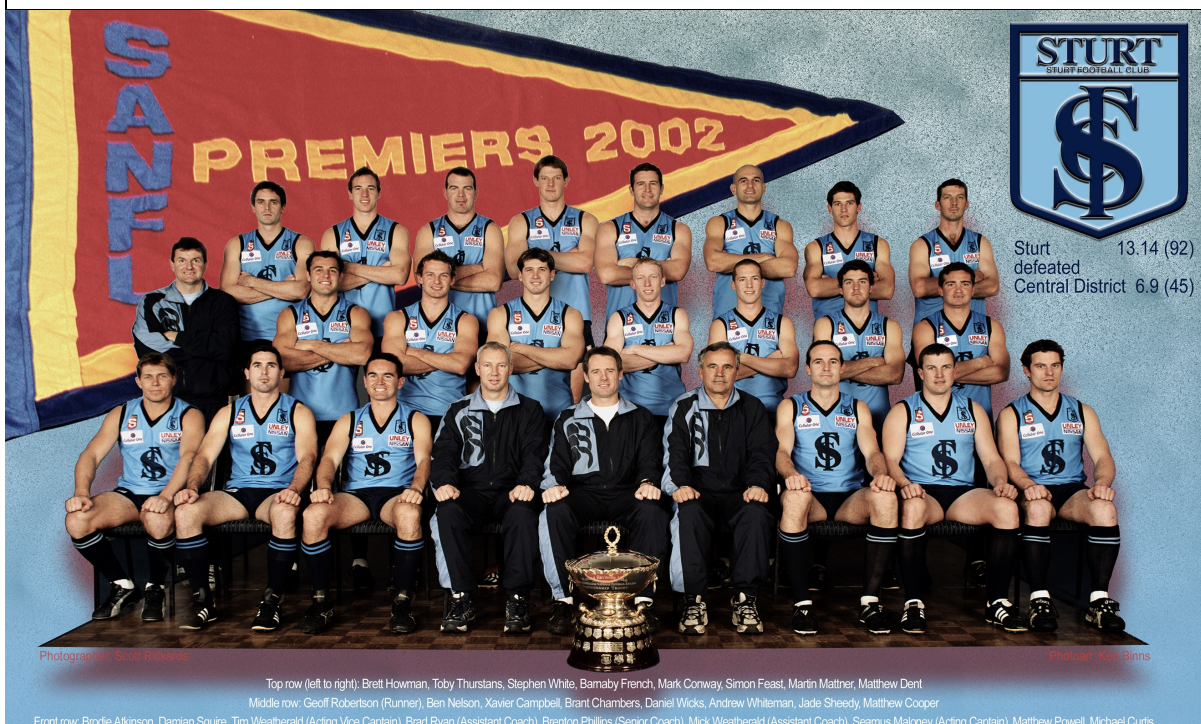

### Match Summary

Central District looked poised for three consecutive Premierships having lost only two minor round games for the 2002 season. However, Sturt had a different idea kicking 4.6 to 0.1 to lead by 29 points at the quarter time break. The Double Blues extended their lead in the second quarter adding 4.1 to 2.3. The margin was 39 points at the half time break. Sturt supporters were equally pleased and stunned by the apparent ease their team displayed in shrugging off the reigning Premiers. With both sides kicking 3 goals in the third quarter Sturt led by 42 points at the final break. Central District were no match for Sturt who went on to win by 47 points to claim the Club's first flag since 1976. Matthew Powell won the Jack Oatey Medal. Best players included Barnaby French, Damian Squire, Michael Curtis, Seamus Maloney, Andrew Whiteman and Marty Mattner while up forward Stephen White kicked 3 goals.



## IN MEMORIAM

### TERRY SHORT

The Club is saddened to advise the passing of former Premiership player, Life Member (Sturt & SANFL) and Sturt Hall of Fame member Terry Short.

A local product, Short captained the Colonel Light Gardens Primary School team before moving on to Unley High School and then Sturt's Colts where he won the Senior Colts Best & Fairest Award in 1960.

Terry went on to play 248 League games between 1961 and 1972 and was a member of six consecutive Grand Final teams, winning five consecutive Premierships. He played in all six of those Grand Finals in the same position - half back flank - a position that he manned with fortitude, pace, persistence and no small amount of skill for almost his entire career.

He also won the Club Champion Award in 1963, just his third season of League football, was Vice Captain in 1965 and went on to coach the Sturt Reserves team in 1973, while also being available for League selection if required that year.

A superb reader of the play, he provided excellent rebound and drive, and opponents under-estimated him at their peril.

Legendary Sturt coach Jack Oatey certainly knew Short's value, including him on a half back flank - where else? - in his 'Vintage 21', a combination comprising the best players to be coached by him during his 21-year tenure at Unley.



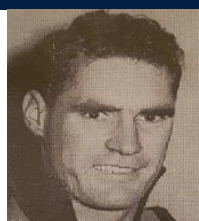
### DENNIS RATTIGAN

The Club advises that past player and Life Member Dennis Rattigan passed away on Thursday the 7th of July 2022.

Growing up in Glandore and then later in Unley, Dennis began his career at Sturt in the Colt teams before progressing through the ranks, playing in the Reserves Premiership in 1949 and then making his League debut on the 22 April 1950 in the opening round of the season.

Although only six foot tall Dennis initially played as a ruckman due to his impressive jumping ability before moving to full back later on in his career and was forced to play in a variety of positions throughout the 1950's due to the weaker Sturt teams at that time. He played 157 games between 1950 and 1959 and also went on to represent South Australia on 9 occasions where he played mostly in the ruck.

During his career at Sturt he was also a Vice Captain, a selector, a player representative and on the main committee.



### GEORGE SWINGLER

It is with much sadness we advise that George Swingler passed away peacefully on Tuesday 6th of September, 2022 at St. Basil's Aegean Village, Christie Downs.

George was the Under 17's & 19's Timekeeper, then, Reserves Timekeeper between 1990 and 2015 before 'handing over the reigns' to current Reserves Timekeeper, Cathy Benfield. He also filled in as League Timekeeper on occasions when Chris Ward was absent.

He then continued to watch the senior men play with his late wife, Janet, who passed away on 17th November 2021, until age and ill health prevented them from attending.

George was awarded Life Membership of the Sturt Football Club in 2005. He insisted that his framed Life Membership certificate was hung on the wall in his room at St. Basil's Aegean Village.
