FOOTBALL MANAGER'S REPORT

Season 2023 can be reflected on as a year that the Club took a big step forward. To have four teams make the Grand Final (League/Reserves/U18s/U16s), the Women's team make finals and the Wheelchair team finish as Premiers for a third year in a row is a remarkable achievement and one that will set the Club up for sustained success.



Unfortunately, we were unable to reach the ultimate goal of a League Premiership, however it is clear to see that we are headed in the right direction and we must look at the positives from the season that was. The League side finished in second position after the minor round with a 14-4 record before defeat in the Grand Final against a very strong Glenelg side. The Senior squad is still relatively young so this Grand Final experience will have a big impact on their long-term development. Sturt was represented through 34 players at Men's League level this season with 8 of those players making their League debut for the Club.

Credit for the continued success of the Senior and Junior programs couldn't be possible without the direction and support of the Board, in particular Jason Kilic as President and Chris Thredgold as Football Director. Jason and Chris' leadership drives the football department in a positive direction as we strive to get better everyday.

We are lucky to have an experienced Senior coaching group who dedicate countless hours to provide a quality football environment. Scott Prebble (Talent Manager) joined the football department in January (replacing Michael Higgs) and he along with David Oatey (High Performance Manager) did an excellent job of developing the talent in our promotional zone. The U18s coached by Paul Scott had a great season making it through to the Grand Final unfortunately going down by 2 points. The U16s had a fantastic season finishing top after the minor round but unfortunately went down in a tightly fought Grand Final. TALENT MANAGER'S REPORT

Throughout the year the junior program had many success stories. Grand Finals, State representatives, and Loch Rawlinson being drafted by the West Coast Eagles with the first pick in the 2023 AFL Rookie draft.



With big squads in our Centre of Excellence programs, it is a credit to all the coaches and support staff for maximising the opportunities for all players involved. It is difficult to manage a group this large however it was done with utmost professionalism and without compromising.

Our Under 16 team was ultra-consistent, and coach David Oatey had the players playing well beyond their years on a regular basis. The talent that this group has is exciting for the future of the Sturt Football Club.

Our Under 18 team was not as consistent having an up-and-down season based on player availability due mainly to College Football. However, Paul Scott as a first-year head coach managed the group magnificently. With missing the finals a real possibility, the last game of the year against Glenelg required the margin to be less than 8 points and we managed to achieve that making the finals by 0.2 percent. It was a huge achievement to then go on and play in a Grand Final.

In 2023 Sturt Juniors achieved the following -

- Two Grand Finals for our Under 16 & Under 18 Programs. Unfortunately, we did not win a premiership however it was a fantastic experience for our young talent to play on Adelaide Oval and a positive sign of things to come.
- Noah Roberts-Thomson, Louis Kellaway, Harley Barker and Blake Thredgold played State Under 16 football, and all performed well. Naite Slade was named as an All-Australian Under 15 schoolboy - this is a huge achievement.
- Alex Holt, Declan Gladigau, Luca Slade and Loch Rawlinson played State Under 18 football and represented the club well.
- Alex Holt, Luca Slade, Loch Rawlinson and Henry Maerschel were nominated for the South Australian AFL Draft Combine. A huge effort from those men and Sturt Football Club to have our talent recognised by AFL Clubs.
- Eight players representing Sturt in the Under 17 futures game with three players being selected to be a part of the SANFL Under 18 State Academy (Sam Waltham, Cameron Kelly, Harley Barker).

A season does not go by without its challenges, the biggest one being the unavailability of Unley Oval. Re-locating training and games on the brink of finals was unsettling, however the resilience of our group was outstanding and the 'just get the job done' attitude played a part in being able to manage difficult situations on and off the field. I would like to thank the players families for being so flexible throughout these changes.

As one season ends, another one begins. We move into season 2024 with some big changes to the junior football department with the departure of David Oatey who has served the club for more than eight years. His wealth of knowledge and experience will be missed however we thank him for his service and wish him all the best for the future.

HIGH PERFORMANCE MANAGER'S REPORT

In October of 2022, I observed the Under 15 carnival, where our team encountered a challenging start by losing five out of six games with significant score disparities. During that time, I recall expressing to former Talent Manager, Michael Higgs, "It might be a long season ahead." However, we decided to commence our preseason training a bit earlier than usual, and I was pleasantly surprised by the players' enthusiasm and dedication to improve.



Following the holiday season, we began with a roster of 58 players, consisting of 25 college players and 33 non-college players. The college players often had to balance school football commitments, causing them to miss approximately 10 minor-round games. While 58 players may seem like a sizable squad, it became apparent that factors such as injuries, players joining State teams, and some departing from the group (including two players who left early in the season due to non-selection) could make it challenging to field a complete team during Terms II and III. Within this squad, we had 12 Under 15 players and 46 Under 16 players.

Remarkably, our performances displayed remarkable consistency, with nearly all 58 players contributing. This attests to the dedication of our coaches in ensuring that players understood their roles and had the necessary skills to excel at this level. It also reflects the collective improvement achieved through hard work and diligence in training.

Several of our players, namely Noah Roberts-Thomson, Louis Kellaway, Harley Barker, Blake Thredgold, and Naite Slade, achieved notable success at the State and national levels, demonstrating their talent and dedication.

During the minor round, we demonstrated exceptional defensive prowess, outscoring the second-ranked team by 250 points. Offensively, we were the top-scoring team, surpassing Centrals by 108 points and the lowest-ranked team by 298 points. In total, we secured victory in 13 games while suffering 5 losses.

Our journey culminated in a Semi-Final victory with a 33-point margin and a remarkable defensive performance, holding Centrals to just 39 points. However, the Grand Final ended in a disappointing 20-point loss, a bitter pill for our players to swallow. This experience offered crucial lessons, emphasising the importance of maintaining composure under pressure, controlling nerves in high-stress situations, and not deviating from our established style of play. These lessons extend beyond football and can benefit the players in various life experiences.

Strong leadership played a pivotal role in our success, with different personalities among the leaders. Leadership sessions facilitated by Todd Sibbin fostered a strong connection within the playing group, ensuring that all players felt comfortable both in training and during games. The leadership group, led by Captain Noah Roberts-Thomson, included Harley Barker, Sam White, Jett Dahlitz, Fergus Kempe, Jackson Moody, and Gill Wakelin.

Our dedicated support staff, including assistant coaches, trainers, physiotherapists, team manager, bench coach, strength and conditioning coach, leadership mentor, head coach, and talent manager, played an essential role in helping our players pursue their goals. Their commitment over 11 months to educate and care for the players was invaluable.

Managing such a comprehensive program with numerous players and parents presented its challenges. Not everyone shared the same goals, and occasional information gaps led to increased communication demands. I extend my gratitude to the Sturt Football Club board, football director Chris Thredgold, Chris Trapp, and Marty Mattner for their unwavering support and leadership. Scott Prebble, who took on the role of Talent Manager mid-season, navigated the challenges admirably, demonstrating composure and dedication.

Our team faced logistical challenges, including venue changes due to cricket activities and reseeding, along with wet weather disruptions during the finals. I understand the sacrifices made by parents who invested time and effort into supporting their children in this elite program. I want to express my appreciation for their understanding, flexibility, and positive behaviour at games, which significantly contributed to our players' performances on match days.

Lastly, I'm proud to announce our award recipients: Blake Thredgold as the Most Valuable Player, and Sam White, Ryan Davies, and Jett Dahlitz receiving the Coaches' Awards.

In summary, the 2023 season was a journey filled with challenges and growth. We learned valuable lessons and witnessed exceptional dedication from players, coaches, staff, and parents. I look forward to an even more successful season in 2024.

In season 2023, our SANFLW League team played finals for the second consecutive year after finishing the minor round season in 4th place with 6 wins and 6 losses. Unfortunately the team couldn't progress past the first week of finals, losing the 1st Semi Final against Norwood. The core group of players have built a strong foundation and I strongly believe this group is in a position to consistently play finals and challenge for a premiership for a sustained period.



The SANFLW Development League team finished their 7 game season in 3rd place with 4 wins and 3 losses. The majority of this team has come through our junior programs and to highlight this we fielded the second youngest team in the competition with an average age of 20. It was great to see the development of this team throughout the season and I have no doubt a number of these players will play League football in the years ahead.

Four players represented the undefeated SA U18 team - Monique Bessen, India Rasheed, Zara Walsh and Lily Whitcombe while three players played in the SA U16 team - Monique Bessen, Sophie Thredgold and Edwina Thornquest. To all medical and high performance staff including Danielle Tape, Laura Holmes, Liam Mathews, Jacquie Addison, Marco Coscia, Matthew van Pelt and Lucy Griffith, thank you for the care and professionalism you showed towards all players throughout the season. Also, thank you to Stephen Mallett who was the timekeeper for League and Development League games throughout the season.

Giang Danh was awarded the medal for Best on Ground.

The team was extremely well led by our Captain Steven Avery and all team members had important contributions throughout the season. Mat Gregory was awarded the League Best & Fairest Award and he also won the Sturt Best & Fairest Award while Johnny Phanratry was Runner Up.

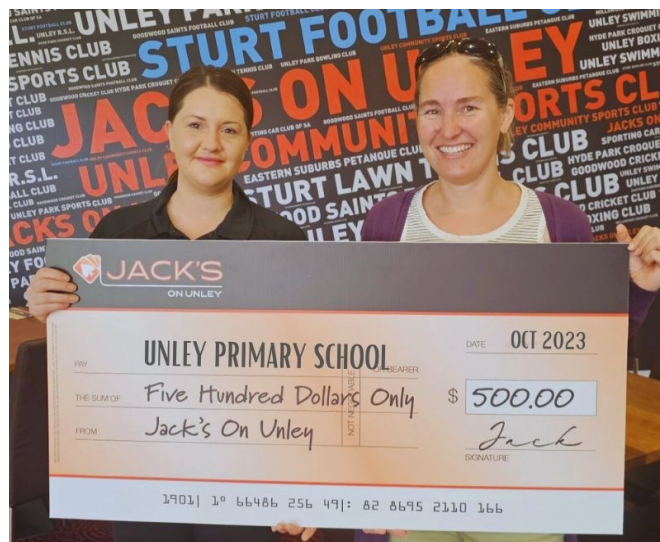

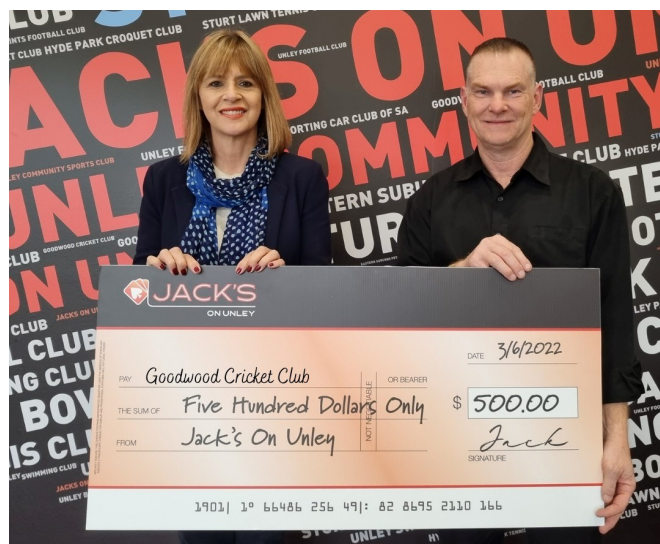

DAVID "DAFFY" EDWARDS

The Club advises that Life Member David "Daffy" Edwards has passed away.

David was well known as the "A" Grade Runner from 1964 – 1978.

In the 1976 Grand Final win over Port Adelaide where Sturt ruckman Rick Davies dominated and played at Football Park before a record crowd of 66,897. Sturt went into the match as underdogs.

In the first quarter Davies, sensing early pressure from Port, positioned himself in the back lines. In an often quoted anecdote, coach Jack Oatey turned to runner David "Daffy" Edwards and said: 'What's he doing down there? I didn't put him down there. I run this side. Go and ask him what he thinks he's up to.' After Davies had taken his fourth strong mark, Edwards came back with the news: "He says he's down there getting kicks, that's where the ball is." Oatey's response: "Course he is. He's a champion" Legend has it that Daffy endured an ear bashing with lots of colourful language from both coach and player that day.

Rest in Peace Daffy.

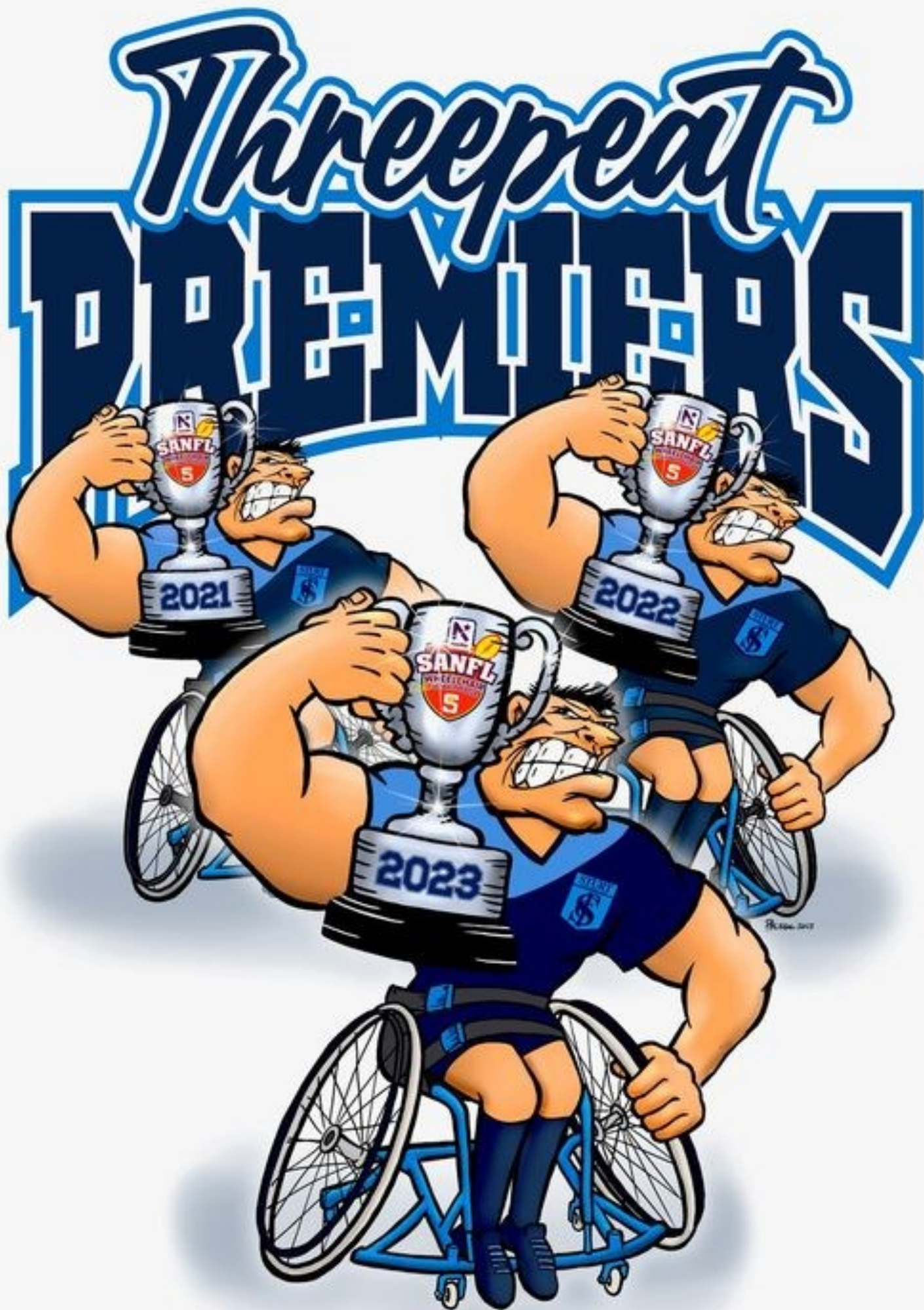

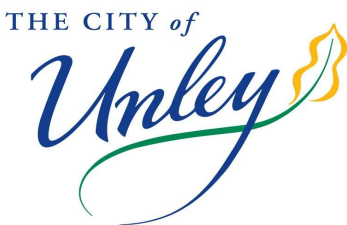

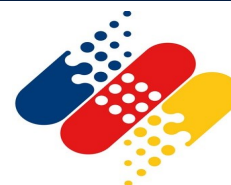
