A BEQUEST

Bequests to Sturt Football Club, made after you have taken care of your loved ones, means your Legacy will live on through the Club.

By leaving a Bequest, no matter how large or small, in your Will to Sturt Football Club you can ensure that you will be preserving our history and helping to create an exciting future for generations to come.

Up to one third of South Australians pass away without leaving their intentions clear in their Will. Sturt Football Club can arrange an initial complimentary consultation (subsequent meetings can be charged) with our Lawyers to prepare your Will if you would like to leave a Bequest to the Club.

HOW DO I LEAVE A BEQUEST TO STURT?

There are several kinds of Bequests you could consider including a residue of your Estate, a percentage of your Estate, a specific gift or specific items of value.

In establishing your bequest plans, we ask you to consider these suggestions:

- Make sure you use our correct name — Sturt Football Club
- Once you have made adequate provisions for your loved ones in your Will, please consider leaving the residue to the Club
- You can also consider making an In Memoriam bequest to honour an individual or family.

SEEK PROFESSIONAL LEGAL COUNSEL:

We strongly recommend you seek the advice of a qualified legal advisor before making or changing your Will, and before choosing executors to administer your Estate.

They can help determine:

- The appropriate gift level for each beneficiary
- The type of gift to make, e.g. specific sum, all or part of an asset, a proportion of your Estate, or all or part of the residue of your Estate
- The tax implications of your gift
- How to best structure the gift to each beneficiary

SUGGESTED WORDING

While there are several types of Bequest clauses the following is used for general Bequests:

I give to Sturt Football Club _____% of my Estate, OR _____% of the residual of my Estate, OR I give to Sturt Football Club the sum of \$_____ to be used for its general purposes. The receipt of any authorised officer Sturt Football Club will be sufficient discharge to my Executor/Trustee.”

Our legal advisers can provide further information on the different types of bequests, and on the appropriate wording.

CHARITABLE TRUST

Another way of leaving a lasting gift is to set up a Charitable Trust in the family name. The capital of the Estate is invested and the annual interest is used by the Club to support its programs. **As well as having tax advantages, your Gift will live on.**
